Crisis Shelter of Lawrence County
The Crisis Shelter of Lawrence County empowers and advocates for those affected by domestic violence, sexual assault, and other violent crimes. They inspire and educate citizens to create safer communities and break the cycle of violence.

Mission Aviation Fellowship
This is a Christian organization that provides aviation, communications, and learning technology services to more than 1,000 Christian and humanitarian agencies as well as thousands of isolated missionaries and indigenous villages. There are three major operational centers—Nampa (Idaho), Ashford (United Kingdom) and Caima (Australia.) Clen-Moore has been personally involved with this ministry since the 1950's.

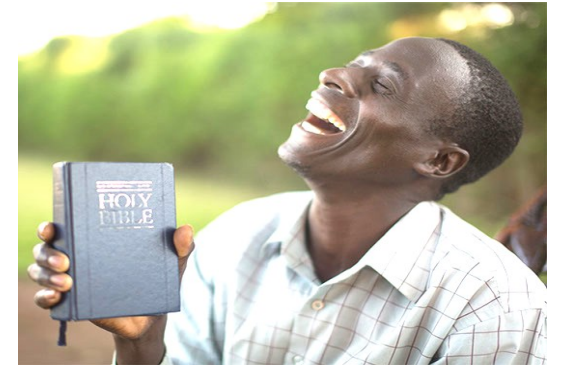
The Camping Association of the Presbyteries of Northwest Pennsylvania operate Camp Lambec and Westminster Highlands and serves the youth in the Presbyteries of Beaver/Butler, Kiskiminetas, Lake Erie, and Shenango, which are part of the Synod of the Trinity.

The Outreach Foundation

This organization was established in 1979 and is independently governed by a board of trustee, all of whom are pastors or officers in their respective congregations. The Outreach Foundation engages Presbyterian and global partners in proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ.

Scott & Elmarie Parker

This couple serves in the Middle East and works with “Strong Kids/Strong Emotions.” The purpose behind this mission is to use art, music, drama and puppets to create a safe place for refugee kids from Iraq and Syria.



Caleb International Ministries

The mission is to serve the Body of Christ as a Para-Church Ministry, crossing religious and cultural borders open to diversity within denominations, communities and nations. The primary target population is “serving those who serve” and includes Church Leaders, Pastors, Missionaries, Elders/Deacons, Directors of Ministries, etc. They are serving in India primarily. The Executive minister is Rev. Louis LaGotta.

1-2-1 (formerly Big Brothers/Big Sisters)

Clen-Moore has been a strong supporter of Cray Youth & Family Services since 2009. We have provided monetary support and have given of our time and talents through active participation in their Big Brothers/Big Sisters program (now called 1-2-1 Mentoring).

LCYM

Lawrence County Youth Ministries partners with churches and the community to connect teenagers to Jesus Christ and His Church.

4-R-4

Several years ago, Clen-Moore began a mission outreach called 4R4. It services four missionaries that are independent of the General Assembly but are doing the Lord's service in the mission field. They are:

United World Mission whose missionaries and church partners serve alongside Christians in over 48 nations to plant, nourish and reproduce churches that delight the heart of God and surprise the world with the grace of God. We support Kevin and Wendy Mason serving in Hungary.

World Impact is served by Joshua and Terrilyn Pacella who are currently serving in Cochabamba, Bolivia. Fundacion Esperanza manages four orphanages. Sal is in administration and Terrilyn is involved with all four orphanages.

Frontier Fellowship is part of a network of ministries that represent compassion and love and hope to those who have yet to hear the gospel of Jesus with new staff exploring opportunities in Southeast Asia and East Asia. Clen-Moore works with Denise Scuito as our representative.

Latcom is serving in Bolivia to bring the truth of God's Word and the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all levels of society in Bolivia and Spanish speaking civilizations. Our representatives in this mission are Tim & Ceci Ramsey and Nathan & Kathy Ramsey.

Dominican Republic Mission



Since 2007, Clen-Moore has been involved with several other Western PA and Ohio churches in a partnership with La Iglesia Evangelica Dominicana in the Dominican Republic. In addition to providing funding for Christian school scholarships and needed medications, we have had church members participate in the annual trip to the DR with emphases on provision of medical clinics, medical and therapy home visits, scholarship program implementation, teacher education, youth and elementary VBS, and construction projects throughout the community.

Salvation Army of Lawrence County

This is an evangelical part of the universal Christian Church. Its message is based on the Bible. Its ministry is motivated by the love of God. Its mission is to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in His name without discrimination.

NCCA

New Castle Christian Academy is an interdenominational Christian school that offers an excellent academic program in a Christian atmosphere to the children of our community during their formative years.

City Rescue Mission

The purpose is to change lives in western Pennsylvania since 1911 through Men's Ministry, Women's Ministry, Family Care Ministry and Youth Ministry. A support program is available as well as homes for men and women as they seek to improve their lives.

Habitat for Humanity

Habitat for Humanity International was founded in 1976. Lawrence County Habitat for Humanity was organized in 1997 and recently broke ground on the 20th home. It is a non-profit ministry seeking to eliminate poverty housing and homelessness. Clen-Moore at one time funded a home and has helped on countless others.

Chaplaincy Fund

Formerly known as Greater New Castle Ministerial Fellowship. This fund helps support the chaplaincy work in the local hospitals.

Meals on Wheels

This program delivers meals to individuals at home who are unable to purchase or prepare their own meals.



Pine Valley Camp

In 1991 Mathew and Susan Reichert felt a call to serve inter-city youth and rebuild broken lives through Jesus Christ and reach out to a variety of communities in and around Pittsburgh and neighboring states. In 1995 they began providing residential camping to those youth. Clen-Moore youth have become involved in this mission and our church has been supportive of the camp for several years.

Alpha Omega Center

The Alpha Omega Center provides services that meet the emotional, physical, and spiritual needs of abortion-minded and abortion-vulnerable clients. Their vision is to see a community where life is cherished from conception to natural death.
